Annual Tideway Cruise on Saturday 18th May 2019

From Limehouse to Brentford & Teddington, via the Thames Barrier, and Margaretness.

Routine for Fri 17th May.

- 1. Rendezvous in the Cruising Association bar, adjacent to Limehouse Lock, at 1900hrs for the mandatory safety brief and supper.
2. Visitor moorings are on "the wall" in Limehouse Basin, free for 24hrs. When moored, inform the Marina office.

Routine for Sat 18th May

- 1. Low Water North Woolwich @ 0823hrs BST predicted at .4m.
2. Last locking departs Limehouse Lock NLT 0615hrs.
3. Pass through the Barrier, outbound, and stem the last of the ebb at Margaretness.
4. Return through the Barrier, inbound, on the first of the flood, for a leisurely upstream passage.
5. High Water London Bridge @ 1427hrs BST, predicted at 7.1m.
6. High Water Brentford & Teddington @ 1527hrs BST+/- . Thames Lock Brentford staffed from 1330hrs BST.
7. Limehouse departure times depend on the quantity and lengths of boats in the convoy.

- a. All those cruising the tidal Thames are advised to inform their marine insurers.
b. Lifejackets are to be worn on the Tideway.
c. Anchors are to be fitted with 15 metres of chain and 35 metres of cable/warp.
d. Navigation lights and horn to be fitted and working.
e. A strong line, at least 15m in length, to be carried on each vessel for towing purposes.
