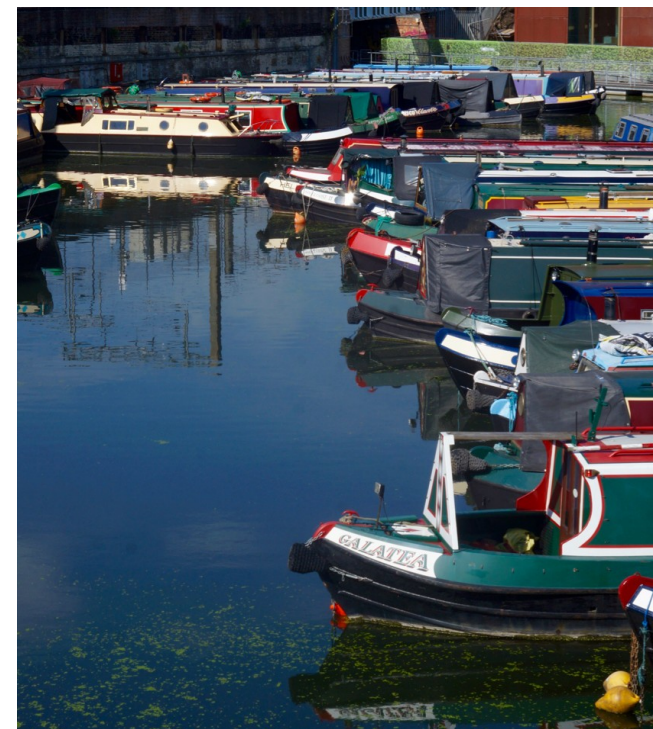

**St Pancras Cruising Club**



St Pancras Cruising Club is a members' club based in Camden that exists to promote pleasure cruising on UK inland waterways and to provide facilities for its members and others.

Most Club members own boats but Club membership is open to anyone who is interested in cruising UK inland waterways. The Club provides non-residential moorings for around 60 boats in St Pancras Basin. Most members' boats are narrow boats but there currently two cruisers and a broad beam boat in the basin.

As well as participating in Club cruises and social events, members are asked to contribute at least 30 hours voluntary work per year to maintain the Club's premises.

Club members are active in promoting the interests of boaters through other waterways organisations at national, regional and local

levels. These include the Canal & River Trust (CRT), the Inland Waterways Association (IWA), the Association of Waterways Cruising Clubs (AWCC), the Association of Lea Cruising Clubs (ALCC), the Association of Thames Yacht Clubs (ATYC) and the Royal Yachting Association (RYA).

### **St Pancras Basin**

The Club is based at St Pancras Yacht Basin, which is located beside the Regent's Canal near St Pancras Station. The gardens, clubhouse, Waterpoint and basin are maintained by members working on a voluntary basis, as are the facilities for visiting boaters – toilets, pump out, fuel supply and cassette toilet disposal. Members carry out this work at monthly work parties which also provide an opportunity for social exchange.

### **Cruising and Public Events**



The Club is well known for its promotion of safe boating on the Thames Tideway. As well as publishing a guide to the Tideway, Club

cruises are regularly joined by other boaters, including experienced and inexperienced tideway cruisers. Comprehensive safety briefings precede each cruise, usually combined with a social evening.

The Club also organises canal cruises, and cruises of the Upper Thames in its annual cruising programme and welcomes members and non-members alike. The Club's cruising program is published on the Club web site: <http://www.stpancrascc.co.uk>.

All boaters are welcome to join Club cruises and public events and there is no charge for participation. Advance booking is required for Thames Tideway cruises.
